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# CHW coaching approach

- Framed from an equity lens, centered in uplifting the expertise of:
  - **Individuals with lived experience**
  - **Seasoned CHWs**
  - **CHW allies in the field**
- Support programmatic implementation (Informed by Rapid Assessment and Workplans)
- Relationship-based with emphasis on collaboration and co-creation

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# CHW coaching components

- Development of individualized technical assistance (TA) plans (developed together/monitored by coaching team; NOT an additional deliverable!)
- Ongoing coaching support
- CHW mentorship
- Connection with CHW subject matter experts (SMEs)

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# CHW coach support

- Initial meeting to build relationships, discuss programs, current needs and goals
  - Review **Rapid Assessment** findings
  - Determine which 2109 team members and partners to work with coaching team
  - Develop goals and action steps for technical assistance (TA)
  - Ongoing collaboration with CHW Coaches to support progress
  - Connect to CHW Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) for additional coaching support, mentorship and resources



# response to AMP technical assistance requests

- Coaching team will respond to 2109 programmatic technical assistance (TA) requests submitted in Awards Management Platform (AMP)
- Coaches will work in collaboration with CHW SMEs, CDC staff and CDC SMEs
- Coaches will monitor and update progress

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# examples of support

- Review of CHW job descriptions
- Assistance finding high quality CHW training
- Connection to CHWs who have experience with a particular population
- Ideas for how to develop a SDoH screening and referral process
- How to connect with and/or build capacity of local or state CHW networks or associations
- Support for CHW partner organizations for finding professional development opportunities for CHWs & CHW Supervisors
